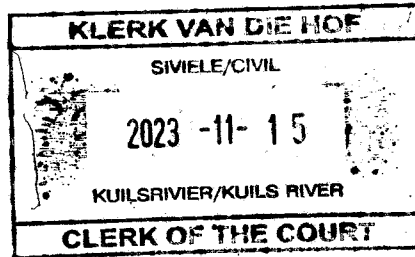

Dear Ms Erasmus,

The Plaintiff agrees to accept service of all subsequent documents and notices via electronic mail.

The Plaintiff sent a letter of demand to the Defendant on 28 January 2022, and the Defendant had until 8 February 2022 to respond. The Defendant acknowledged receipt of the letter of demand, but failed to deliver a response to the Plaintiff within the allocated time.

The Plaintiff proceeded with legal action and served a summons on the Defendant, with Magistrates Court case no. 1399/2022 Fitchat//Johnson.

The sheriff's return of service indicates that he attempted to serve the summons personally on the Defendant twice at his home, once on 11 February 2022 and again on 12 February 2022, but that the Defendant did not open his door either time.

The sheriff properly served the summons on the Defendant by affixing the summons to the Defendant's outer door on 12 February 2022.

Therefore the Defendant's notice of intention to defend was due on 25 February 2022.

The Defendant failed to file and serve a notice of intention to defend by 25 February 2022, so the matter was submitted for default judgment on 3 March 2022.

Despite the sheriff having properly served the Defendant, on 28 March 2022 the Defendant's wife claimed that the Defendant had not been served with the summons by the sheriff, but that he first learned of the summons through the Plaintiff's reply to the Defendant's wife's complaint regarding the Plaintiff's CCTV cameras to CSOS.

The Plaintiff's same reply on 28 March 2022 to the Defendant's wife indicated that the matter had been submitted for default judgment.

The next day, on 29 March 2022, the Defendant's attorney sent the Defendant's notice of intention to defend to the Plaintiff via an email, and the Plaintiff received it on the same day.

The Plaintiff received the same notice of intention to defend via the sheriff on 4 April 2022.

Since the Plaintiff received the Defendant's notice of intention to defend on 29 March 2022, the Defendant's plea, exception, or notice to strike out, with or without a counterclaim were due on 29 April 2022 (20 days after receiving the Defendant's notice of intention to defend).

The Plaintiff did not receive a plea, exception, or notice to strike out, with or without a counterclaim, from the Defendant by 29 April 2022.

The Plaintiff received an email from the Defendant's attorneys with their plea attached on 2 May 2022, which was past the deadline.

The Defendant has defaulted by failing to deliver his plea by the deadline, therefore judgment may be given against him.

The Defendant is in default of submitting a plea, and the Uniform Rules of Court do not provide for the Defendant to be placed out of default, by sending his plea after the deadline.

The Defendant had full knowledge that the Plaintiff had applied for a default judgment against him, but he still chose to send his plea late.

The Plaintiff is not willing to grant the Defendant an extension to submit his plea in light of his repeated and wilful disregard for deadlines, as detailed above.
